WHERE ARE WE NOW?


- Article 50 triggered UK to leave EU by 29 March 2019
- European Union (Withdrawal) Act 2018
- Withdrawal agreement
 - Target date of November to agree
 - If deal, ratification in January 2019
 - If no deal, contingency plan to be invoked 21 January 2019
- Possible transition period until 31 December 2020
- Free trade agreements
- Regulatory divergence / alignment
- Politics
- Global view





EUROPEAN UNION (WITHDRAWAL) ACT 2018

- Repeal of European Communities Act 1972
- Conversion of existing EU law into domestic law
- Creation of powers to make secondary legislation, including temporary powers to enable corrections to be made to laws that would otherwise no longer operate appropriately once the UK has left the EU and to implement a withdrawal agreement
- Aim: to maximise legal certainty and preserve the status quo










SECURITIES LAW

FINANCE


- Financial Passporting


